

CPW Minutes

June 2018

Due to very meager attendance, no votes were taken, the meeting focused on updates and discussion concerning upcoming CPW fundraisers.

Treasury Report: As of meeting Checking Account balance was \$6489, and Money Market Account balance was \$24,563.

Jazz Fundraiser: CPW will sell beer wine and bourbon again at the Jazz in Central Park on August 26th. CPW has also been contracted by Organizers to pick up trash during and after the event. Extra volunteers will need to be recruited for this.

Cafe Fundraiser: Treasurer Johnson has been working to get all appropriate permissions and licenses. She also has been in discussion with Elaine at 3rd St Assoc about transitioning the Cafe away from food sales. 3rd St Assoc is fine with CPW no longer offering a full menu, and with the additional sale of bourbon at the event. They did stipulate that they would like CPW to continue with the live music and tents/seating at the site, along with the sale of flights of bourbon.

Due to insurance and licensing concerns, CPW will continue the sale of snack boxes, since not providing food would change our classification. Decision was made to rent only ½ the number of tables and chair for the seating area though.

Discussed the concern of Fair Organizers about the Hep A virus and food service. Concern voiced about verification of volunteers vaccination status, and whether that would reduce volunteer participation. Decision made to email all potential volunteers to encourage getting the vaccine, but to go no further in requiring verification for volunteering.
